MILLENNIUM CHALLENGE ACCOUNT NEPAL (MCA-Nepal)

The Millennium Challenge Compact between the United States of America, acting through the Millennium Challenge Corporation ("MCC"), and the Government of Nepal (the "Government" or "GoN)) signed on September 14, 2017 (the "Compact") sets forth the general terms on which MCC will provide assistance of up to Five Hundred Million United States Dollars (US\$500,000,000) ("MCC Funding") to the Government for a program to reduce poverty through economic growth in Nepal (the "Program"). The Compact includes an additional investment of US\$130 million from the Government, for a total of approximately US\$630 million. The Government intends to apply parts of the proceeds of the funds to payments for contracts for goods, works and services to assist the Government with the implementation of the Compact program in a transparent and sound manner.

The procurement program for the next 9 months will include the following:
