MCA-Nepal invites the interested eligible firms for submission of Expressions of Interest to provide the consultant services as "Transportation assessment to transport bulk/large cargo from India border custom location to MCA-Nepal designated proposed Substation locations (Roads Assessment Survey).

1	A minimum of ten (10) years of overall experience with an extensive demonstrated familiarity on design of roads and bridges;	
2	At least two (2) similar Projects involving assessment of roads and bridges for transportation of bulk and heavy cargo by road in the last 10 years;	
3	Provide CV for Bridge Design Engineer who has carried out similar assessment of cross drainage structures to transport heavy and bulky cargo exceeding 100 tons for at least two (2) assignments over the last ten (10) years. Names of the projects involved with reference address (contact numbers and email ID) of clients to be clearly indicated in the CVs provided.	

Procurement will be conducted through the **Consultant's Qualification Selection (CQS)** method as specified in the MCC Program Procurement Guidelines (PPG), and is open to all eligible bidders or consultants as defined in the PPG.
