SN	Questions	Response of Millennium Challenge Account Nepal (MCA-Nepal)
1.	Before submitting the application, I would appreciate knowing whether I am eligible to apply for it as I am already in a Pool of Senior Policy Advisors with MCA-Nepal. It is possible to maintain two contracts if I am also selected for it.	It is possible to apply for this position even if you have another short/term Technical Evaluation Panel (TEP/BRP) member or Senior Policy Advisors Contract with MCA-Nepal.
2.	<p>I have sent my acceptance on amendment of the existing contract.</p> <p>However, on last April 10, 2022, there was an advertisement published in Kantipur calling for the individual consultant for their registration. I got confused whether I have to submit my application again? My contract is still valid until 22 June 2022. Please clarify.</p> <p>Second, I have been registered under PAN, now you asked for VAT registration even for individuals. I have enquired with the VAT office whether I have to register again under VAT, But they said if you have PAN then no need to register under VAT. I need your clarification on this too.</p>	<p>The existing contracts of the TEP/BRP Members have been extended only for 1 year.</p> <p>For this new procurement, the Request for Application (RFA) has the provision of contract duration for 60 months. Thus, this will be a separate contract.</p> <p>Consequently, the current TEP/BRP Consultants are <b>highly encouraged to submit an application for this procurement.</b></p> <p>Please note that as per the financial regulations of MCA-Nepal and Government of Nepal, a VAT invoice is mandatory requirement for payment of the fees against any services provided. Thus, when a task order is issued, the consultant will be required to submit a VAT invoice.</p> <p>Hence, the VAT registration is mandatory if MCA-Nepal issues a task order to the consultant, which will only be issued if the MCA-Nepal needs consultant's input.</p>
3.	Why is the dates (deadline for submission) being changed continuously?	To provide an opportunity to prospective applicants for submitting the application

		and broaden the pool of applicants for the TEP/BRP Members.

This is regarding your RFP on “Pool of Consultants for intermittent assignments to serve as Technical Evaluation Panel (TEP)/Bid Review Panel (BRP) Members or Assignments related to their expertise” Ref # MCA-N/PM/ICS/044, please advise what documents to be enclosed for the evaluation criteria c: "Demonstrable professional proficiency in English".	<p>There is no requirement to provide the documents to demonstrate professional proficiency in English.</p> <p>The consultant is required to provide the language related information in the "Form 2: Curriculum Vitae (CV)" of the Request for Application, in which the consultant need to indicate proficiency of languages including English Language.</p>
5.	I am already contracted with MCA-Nepal on the TEP for the support to ERC. This was almost 2 years back. I presume I have to submit a fresh application. Do we have a list of assignments that the current RFP will cover?	<p>The pool of TEP Members for ERC will provide the technical evaluation services for ERC related procurement only.</p> <p>This Procurement will cover all major procurements to be launched under MCA-Nepal. The consultants who wish to be part of this pool of TEP/BRP must submit a fresh application.
